The Chautauqua Board of Directors will host a Town Hall Meeting **Saturday, May 28 at 9 am** in Town Hall. Updates and drawings on the proposed frontgate renovation plan will be shared as well as reports from the grounds and forward planning committees. There will also be a preview of the finances and budget for the 2022 season. All are welcome to attend!
